

WORLD LIT TENTATIVE SCHEDULE, FALL 2020

- Please, please, please read this schedule alongside and in conjunction with the syllabus and especially the Ariadne's Thread: Your Guide to World Lit document. If you read the schedule without reading these two things, you'll likely end up confused, flustered, and frazzled, and we don't want that.
- I'll typically email commentary, course content, info, updates, and reminders on Mondays and Wednesdays, and occasionally on Fridays as needed. I can't set exact email times, though I'll aim for 3:30 or sooner. These emails won't be superfluous; if you don't read them, you'll basically be missing the class. I typically won't send class emails on Tuesdays, Thursdays, or weekends. You're welcome to email me or reach out through GroupMe anytime.
- I'll include reminders and pacing suggestions in my weekly emails. Basically, do read the schedule, but don't stress about processing it all at once.
- On days that say we'll begin a verse, I will send you the content guide sheet for that verse on that day. So, for example, I'll send you the content guide sheet for Verse 1: Deep Time on August 24, and so on. You can go through the content guide sheet (i.e., read/watch/listen to the material on it) self-paced and at your leisure, but you should plan to complete it all by the time the next verse begins. So, for example, you should plan to read/watch/listen to all the material on the Verse 1 content guide sheet (coming your way August 24) by September 9 (which is the day I'll send you the content guide sheet for Verse 2). Cool?
- WTF: This refers to the Fairy Category: WTF Journal. On the days you see "WTF" listed below (all Mondays with one exception), I'll send you the prompt for that day. My recommendation is you complete each journal entry the week I send the prompt. If something comes up any given week, you can go back and "make up" previous entries. Just don't fall too far behind. The journal shouldn't be a chore. It's meant to be enjoyable.
- Unicorn: Verse Reflections: You can submit these two at a time according to the dates listed, or you can submit all six at the same time on December 4. No matter which option you choose, I recommend completing each verse reflection within a week of finishing a given verse. For example, I recommend completing the reflection for Verse 1 by September 16, and so on. Again, I'll include these recommendations in my weekly emails.
- All Zooms listed are encouraged but optional. Zooms are mostly opportunities for you to share and listen to your classmates and me share WTF journal entries and have open discussions about course content. I'll send general agendas for each Zoom meeting as they get closer.
- It might help to think of this schedule as more of a pacing guide. All due dates below are highly, highly suggested, but none are firm with the exception of quizzes and the final late work due date. If you have extenuating circumstances that prevent you from submitting a quiz on time—though as you'll see, you have a week to complete each quiz—simply let me know in an email and we'll discuss. But generally, I like to think of "due dates" more as guides or benchmarks. Here's what I mean: Even though the coursework proposal is due September 4, if you submit on, say, September 8, that's not a big deal to me. Just don't let things like that pile up. The last day I can accept any late work is noon on December 15. Submitting work early is fine.
- If you ever want to set up an individual/small group conference over Zoom or phone, just email me your availability and we'll make it happen.
